# Auction Information & Rules

## General

1. Every effort has been made to ensure accuracy prior to displaying the fair market value (FMV) of all the items before the auction begins. The bidders need to know the value of all the items in advance of the auction. The FMV has been established on the basis of an official receipt, invoice or professional appraisal.
2. The Racing for a Cure Committee reserves the right to withdraw any item from the auction prior to the call for bids.
3. By bidding on an auction item, you agree to these Auction Rules and expressly agree that all merchandise is sold on an “AS IS, WHERE IS” basis and that the Racing for a Cure Committee makes no warranties, expressed or implied, or representations in connection with the sale of any item. **All items are non-refundable.**
4. Dates are to be mutually agreed upon between the purchaser and the donor, where applicable.
5. All auction items and services must be used within one year of the date of the auction unless otherwise specified by the donor.
6. Taxes and tips are not included in the item’s value, unless specifically noted.
7. Charitable tax receipts cannot be issued for priceless items as fair market value cannot be determined.

## **Payment**

1. Payment in full is required prior to redeeming the item. Payment can be made by MasterCard, Visa, Amex, personal cheque, company cheque, debit or cash.
2. All sales are final. No exchanges or refunds will be honoured by the Stollery Children's Hospital Foundation, the Racing for a Cure Committee or donors.

## **Live Auction**

1. If the auctioneer determines the bidding does not reflect the value of the item being offered, he or she may reject all bids and withdraw the item for sale.
2. In the event of a dispute, the auctioneer shall have the sole and final discretion to determine the successful bidder with assistance from a Racing for a Cure Committee representative.

## **Silent Auction**

1. A minimum bidding increment will be set for each auction item. You must enter a bid using at least the minimum increment, although you may choose to bid higher. Additional information and instruction may be communicated at the event.
2. The silent auction will commence at 6 p.m. and close at 10:00 p.m. You may bid on any item in the silent auction, until the auction is closed.
3. The Emcee will make an announcement 5 minutes prior to closing. Participants will have 5 minutes to make a final bid. Winning bids will be highlighted. Bidders are responsible for checking if their bid was successful. Volunteers will be available to assist with questions.

4. All auction items must be removed *by 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 14, 2025*. Items not removed by that time will be stored at the purchaser's expense. Auction items will only be retained by the Racing for a Cure Committee until July 31, 2025.

## **Travel Packages**

1. Travel packages do not include taxes, air, land or water transportation unless directly stated in the auction listing.
2. All items purchased are for use described, including all limitations with respect to dates and number of people. No amendments will be permitted. The purchaser will be responsible for any and all damages to any property caused by the purchaser and/or their guests during their time of stay. Incidental charges may be incurred as a result of the purchaser's use of the property and are the sole responsibility of the purchaser.

## **Charitable Tax Receipts**

Tax receipts can be issued for bids where the successful bid is at least 20% above the fair market value of the auction item. Example: Fair market value is \$500. Minimum successful bid to qualify for a charitable tax receipt is \$600. A charitable tax receipt can be issued for \$100 as per Canada Revenue Agency.

All donation forms and backup receipts/invoices must be received by the Stollery Children's Hospital Foundation by July 31, 2025. Charitable tax receipts will be issued and sent out by August 31, 2025. Any requests received after July 31, 2025 will not be eligible for charitable tax receipts.

# Live Canvas Painting

## *Donated by Giselle Denis Fine Artist*

Giselle Denis is an internationally acclaimed, award-winning Artist and Performance Painter, celebrated for her captivating live painting performances around the world. She has showcased her art at prestigious venues, including a residency at the Raffles Hotel in Dubai, and has painted for high-profile events such as the Canadian Embassy and the Special Olympics in Abu Dhabi.

In Canada, Giselle brought her talent to the Explore Edmonton Conference in Quebec City, where she painted live throughout the city. One of her most iconic works, a towering 40x26-foot mural titled "Mother Nature," is a landmark in downtown Edmonton, located just a block from Rogers Place. Her largest piece, an 8x16-foot artwork, was created for the Strathcona Community Hospital.

Giselle is on a mission to raise \$1 million for charity through her art, with over \$900,000 raised to date, including a single painting that sold for \$50,000. Her artistic achievements include the Legislative Assembly of Alberta Award for Excellence in the Arts and the Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Medal.
